

Dear Parents,

This year we will be using a colored “clip chart” to monitor our behavior and classroom choices. Your child will have a clip in the classroom that they will physically move up or down the chart, depending on their choices. Please keep in mind that your child may not move every single day! In order to move up, students must go above and beyond in their behavior choices. The chart below explains how the clip chart works.

Purple Outstanding! (7 points)	Students who reach the purple level will be rewarded for their positive choices. They will also clip up to the principal.
Blue Way to Go! (6 points)	Students who continue to make positive choices move up from the blue level to the purple level. They are one step closer to having outstanding classroom behavior!
Pink Good Day! (5 points)	Students who make Good Day will receive recognition as they move up the chart.
Green We Are Ready to Learn! (4 points)	Everyone starts the day “Ready to Learn”! Students can “clip up” or “clip down” throughout the day depending on their behavior choices.
Orange Think About It! (3 points)	Students who receive a warning will move to orange. This serves as a reminder to students to “think” about the choices they make. (Think Sheet)
Yellow Teacher’s Choice! (2 points)	Students who continue to make poor choices will move to yellow and will be sent to the buddy room in order to allow the student time to turn his/her behavior around.
Red Parent Contact... (1 point)	Students who move to red will miss recess in its entirety and parents will be contacted that day if their child is on red.

I believe that this system will be a positive way for students to monitor their choices and will give them behavior goals to strive for! Each day, you will be sent notification about how many points your child earned for that day. If you have any questions, please don’t hesitate to contact me!
